The Partner agrees :

- To protect and promote the interests of the company and to act dutifully and in good faith.
- To ensure that any relevant paperwork should reach the company in a timely manner

- Not incur any costs of behalf of the company
- Not enter into any contract on behalf of the company
- Not infringe or take ownership of any of the company's' Intellectual Property
- Be accountable for their own taxation and national insurance
- To keep all information concerning the business and company confidential
- Pay £24.00 (£20 plus vat) per month management fee

The Company agrees :

- To deal with all enquiries from the partner in a reasonable time.
- To provide up to date information about the products and services, including any changes and update.
- To provide the agreed Will documentation to the client. The company reserves the right to use third party services of its choosing to produce and supply said documentation.
- To provide professional indemnity insurance for the activities of the company.
- To supply branded website with AfterWills services
- To supply Training Manual
- Ongoing Training and backup
- To supply Business Cards and Flyers designed
- 80% of revenue for each sale, payable on 20th of the following month
- All sales brochure and communications form an integral part of this agreement
- Transfer the ownership of the Partner Agreement if required, or to the Partner's next of kin on death or illness of the partner

Termination

- The Agreement can be terminated by the Partner giving 1 months notice for any reason
- The company can terminate the agreement if the Partner commits a criminal or fraudulent act, becomes bankrupt, by mutual agreement or if the monthly fee is not paid

Jurisdiction

- The law of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland governs this agreement
